Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN GEORGIETOWN RESTAURANT GROUP, LLC; ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION 2E; AND THE CITIZENS ASSOCIATION OF GEORGETOWN

THIS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made on this 12th day of September 2023, by and between Georgietown Restaurant Group, LLC ("Applicant"), Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2E ("ANC2E"), and The Citizens Association of Georgetown ("CAG"), also referred to collectively as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, Applicant has applied for a Retailer's Class B ABC license, ABRA-125204, ("License") for a portion of the ground floor of the Georgetown Market building located at 3276 M Street, NW ("Premises") adjacent to its ABC-licensed Restaurant, ABRA-120570 ("Restaurant"), premises in the same building;

WHEREAS, Parties wish to enter into this Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") pursuant to DC Official Code§ 25-446 to address concerns related to peace, order, and quiet and to eliminate the need for a Protest Hearing regarding the License application;

WHEREAS, Parties request that the Alcoholic Beverage & Cannabis Board ("ABC Board") approve the Applicant's License application conditioned upon Applicant's compliance with the terms of this Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals set forth above and the mutual covenants and conditions set forth below, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Recitals Incorporated. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

2. Hours.

- a. The Hours of Operation shall not exceed: 8:00 am 1:00am weekdays and 8:00am 1:45am weekends.
- b. The Hours of Alcoholic Beverage Sales shall not exceed 8:00 am 1:00am daily.
- c. However, Applicant shall not permit in-person retail sales for off-premise consumption within the Premises after 10:30pm daily excluding Restaurant patrons who have entered the Georgetown Market Building at or before 10:30pm. Restaurant patrons may purchase alcohol from the Premises until 1:00am.
- d. Nothing about the forgoing is meant either to limit the hours during which Applicant may sell, offer for sale, package, or deliver alcoholic beverages via the Internet during its permitted hours of sales.
- 3. Business Operations. Applicant shall not engage in check cashing services or lottery sales as part of its operations under this License.
- 4. Binding Effect. The Agreement shall be binding and enforceable against the Applicant and successors of Applicant.
- 5. No Protest. Upon execution of this Agreement by the Parties and its approval by the ABC Board, and in reliance thereupon, the ANC and CAG shall refrain from filing a protest against the Applicant's License application.
